Westminster **COMMUNITY PANTRY**

- **In June, we served 580 people** from 210 households with 6,773 pounds of food. We had three weeks with more than 55 guests each, a huge jump from just a few months ago. With the help of so many faithful volunteers, we continue the good work of feeding our hungry neighbors!
- **The July "Item of the Month"** is peanut butter (prefer smaller 16 oz size jars). This is a staple that every guest receives, and we want to make sure we are well stocked. Please leave your

donations on the cart outside the pantry door. Thank you!

- **Ongoing: We continue to collect kitchen items for our Christmas tree, books for our Free Little Library, and any produce** you are willing to donate. If you have any **inspirational books or magazines**, please leave them at the church office so we can include them in the **Free Little Library**.
