

Our goal now is to schedule 100 Home Energy Analysis appointments before December 17, 2017. **As of October 26, Westminster had 70 scheduled/completed appointments!**

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The Home Energy Analysis Program offers Michigan residents a 90-minute initial in-home assessment performed by a trained analyst. He or she will perform a visual inspection of your home, install higherficiency measures where needed, and share a customized summary report with energy-saving tips and recommendations for your home.


